When people are ill, they sometimes experience severe pain.



There are doctors who can help with pain.



Medication can help with pain.



You can show how severe the pain is on a board.



Visits can also make you feel better.

Where do I die?



Many people want to die in their own home.



Many people die in hospital.



There are many departments in hospitals . There is also a department for people who are very ill. This department is called: palliative care ward.



People who are seriously ill and dying live in the hospice house. They get a lot of help there..

What a person wants is important, for example, who should be with me when I die?



Some people talk to friends and family about their wishes. Then they write down their wishes.

Many people around the world believe in a god. Some people believe in life after death.

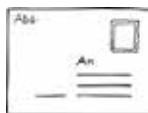


Friends and family are often very sad when someone dies. It often helps if they talk about it with other people. There is a group called the bereavement group.
